

SPARKLING WINE

VILLIERA TRADITION BRUT ROSÉ NV

Stellenbosch: 250-

Joyful, rich pink colour, vivacious cascading bubbles and the full rich flavour of Pinot Noir combined with the elegance of Chardonnay and the uniqueness of Pinotage providing the colour. This is the Tradition Rosé - rich in flavour with a long finish.

LONGRIDGE MCC BRUT RESERVE 2009

Western Cape: 290-

This Vintage Reserve Brut is a Cap Classique produced only during exceptional years from grapes specific to that vintage. This Cuveé has been carefully matured for over 5 years on a fine lees resulting in a wine of extreme elegance and fine mousse.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

VONDELING SAUVIGNON BLANC

Voor Paardeberg: 180-

This historic farm, named for the original Foundling Hospital, was granted to Swedish immigrant Oloff Bergh in 1704. Captivatingly crisp and vibrant, it is an excellent choice to accompany seafood.

IONA SOPHIE TE'BLANCHE SAUVIGNON BLANC

Elgin Valley: 180-

Vibrant pure fruit of cut green apples, zesty limes, gooseberries and tropical notes with white flowers and subtle mineral undertones. Sophie is fresh, crisp, balanced, accessible, playful and delicious!

SOUTHERN RIGHT SAUVIGNON BLANC

Hemel-en-Aarde: 210-

A beautiful marriage of both the Old World and New World styles of wine. In terms of Old World, it has a rich minerality. This is balanced with a New World fruitiness, particularly on the nose. The mid-palate is well structured and adds complexity.

CHARDONNAY

NEWTON-JOHNSON FELICITÉ UNOAKED CHARDONNAY

Hemel-en-Aarde: 140-

Steely aromas of fresh lime and the soft, fruity nuance of peach blossoms. Sumptuous texture in the mouth, integrating bracing acidity in to a refreshing finish.

DE WETSHOF LIMESTONE HILL CHARDONNAY

Robertson: 210-

Character and complexity is gained from aging on fine lees rather than oaking, in this stylish and rich, unwooded chardonnay, with a twist of lime cordial zestiness. For enjoying on its own or with food.

VONDELING CHARDONNAY

Voor-Paardeberg: 240-

Winemaker Matthew Copeland achieves a creamy texture, pierced by zesty citrus flavours and a captivatingly earthy minerality. A classy act, named for the original Foundling Hospital on Voor-Paardeberg farm.

CHENIN BLANC

WATERFORD PECAN STREAM CHENIN BLANC

Stellenbosch: 180-

Quality-driven Waterford's 2nd label wine made to be enjoyed while the fresh tropical fruits and ripe apricot flavours are at their youthful best. Drink on its own, or with a variety of pasta and white meat dishes.

JOOSTENBERG "DIE AGTEROS" CHENIN BLANC

Stellenbosch: 295-


A complex array of aromas and flavours. Hints of baked apple, honey and flint stone. The palate is rich, yet elegant and is marked by a subtle, creamy texture.

WHITE BLENDS

ASHBOURNE SAUVIGNON BLANC-CHARDONNAY

Hemel-en-Aarde: 140-

Fresh, vibrant, perfumed Sauvignon blanc, filled-out and enriched with a carefully judged unwooded Chardonnay component, make this a beautifully balanced and highly versatile wine. More than two decades of family experience have gone into this unique blend.



ROSÉ

KANONKOP KADETTE ROSÉ

Stellenbosch : 160-

A dry but juicy rosé, bled from pinotage grapes which manages to the taste buds tingling with fresh red berry fruit compôte flavours. Staying with the Kanonkop philosophy, this is a savoury, full-bodied and versatile food wine.

CINSAULT

RADFORD DALE THIRST CINSAULT

Stellenbosch: 260-

Between a red and a rosé, this Stellenbosch Cinsault is made by carbonic maceration, producing a light, floral, peppery cranberry aroma, lightweight tannic chassis and just 10% alcohol. A real thirst-quencher.

PINOT NOIR

IONA 'MR P KNOWS' PINOT NOIR

Elgin Valley : 290- : 73-

Made in a light, playfully juicy, dry style with pure cherry and cranberry flavours and underlying earthiness, it is ideal accompaniment to duck, and has sufficient structure to accompany lighter red meat dishes.

PINOTAGE

STELLENRUST PINOTAGE


Stellenbosch: 160-


This wine offers raspberry and ripe peach and black cherry flavours with subtle oak nuances, a ripe juice palate and a delicate lingering finish.

LONGRIDGE PINOTAGE

Stellenbosch: 270-

Exhibits an aromatic bouquet packed with heady notes of black berries, cassis and sugary spices. This well-rounded wine displays wonderful juicy tannins and a long finish with a lovely coffee-infused aftertaste which rounds off this complex wine.





MERLOT

VONDELING PETIT ROUGE

Voor-Paardeberg: 160-

The wine displays a bright ruby red colour. It shows a vibrant, fruit filled aroma of sleek cherries, subtle raspberry and soft, black pepper. The nose carries through beautifully to the palate and is nicely supported by refined tannins with a smooth finish.

BEIN LITTLE MERLOT

Stellenbosch: 220-

Ingrid and Luca Bein's Little Merlot is a wine that emphasizes the fruity side of this variety. It pleases with fresh berry flavors and a silky texture and offers early drinking pleasure.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

TOKARA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Stellenbosch: 220-

This wine has a beautiful garnet colour. There are berry aromas of cassis, red currant and blueberries on the nose, with underlying notes of cocoa, fresh herbs and tobacco spice. The palate is packed with sweet berry fruit, flavours of dark chocolate and briary notes with hints of dried herbs on the finish.

SPRINGFIELD WHOLE BERRY CABERNET

Robertson: 320-

Family winemaker, Abrie Bruwer's quest for traditional winemaking techniques extend to his ripe bunches of cabernet sauvignon, in which 'whole' or uncrushed grapes are fermented with naturally occurring yeasts to extract delicate flavours and plush, soft tannins.

THELEMA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Stellenbosch : 440-

Complex and stylish, with aromas of ripe blackcurrant, dark chocolate and pencil shavings. This wine is bone dry, yet exhibits a lovely sweet fruit character on the palate, with a lovely long finish.

SHIRAZ

FIRST SIGHTINGS SHIRAZ

Elim: 190-

Signature white pepper, blackberry and mocha notes give way to a full silky palate and long spicy finish balanced by savoury tannins. This Shiraz would do well to be served with a tasty steak or hearty beef stew.

HARTENBERG SHIRAZ

Stellenbosch: 360-

Deep black – red in colour and spicy, earthy notes on bouquet entry. Also cloves, red and black berry fruit. The palate is rich, fruit-driven and has great balance. Fine, powdery tannins finish the wine

RED BLENDS

PECAN STREAM PEBBLE HILL

Stellenbosch : 190-

Intriguing blend of Cabernets Sauvignon and Franc, Shiraz and Italian varieties Sangiovese and Barbera. Spicy blackberry fruit is contained by soft supple, oak tannins. Delicious on its own or with food.

DESSERT WINE

375ml

THELEMA VIN DE HEL

MUSCAT LATE HARVEST: 220-

A golden dessert wine with very typical Muscat characters on the nose. The wine shows upfront aromas of pineapple, citrus, apricots, a touch of honey and subtle floral notes. The palate is lush with the perfect balance between sweetness and fresh acidity.
